CBSE Zonal Sports Competition (Far East) – Archery

Guidelines, Rules and Regulations

Guidelines for schools:

Every affiliated school shall be entitled to enter its athlete/team in the CBSE Sports and Games Competitions. As soon as calendar is uploaded on the Board's website, the schools may fill in the online discipline wise Entry Proforma.

No school will be permitted to participate unless they fill the online discipline wise Entry Proforma and by hand Entry Proforma would not be accepted.

No team will be permitted to play unless accompanied by a teacher/coach at the venue.

Dining in the mess arranged by the host school is mandatory for the teams that opt to stay in the school provided accommodation.

Every player/team/athlete shall carry with them the required documents as mentioned under "Eligibility".

Every team will carry their school flag, for the purpose of March past and to be used during the various ceremonies. <u>Participation in the March past is compulsory, failing which their right to participate can be forfeited.</u>

It is not obligatory on the part of Organizing School to provide food and transport facility to school/teams making their own stay arrangements. Also, it is the responsibility of the school/teams staying outside, to collect information in regard to matches/fixtures/program etc.

Any non-designated person accompanying the team will not be entertained for any matter at the venue and will not be permitted to stay in the premises.

In case the player/team is being accompanied only by parent, it should be informed by the principal of the participating school in writing.

Guidelines for Teachers/Coaches/Team Managers:

All teams shall be accompanied by a Teacher/Coach/Manager designated by the participating school Principal.

No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying official.

No team shall be accompanied by any parent. However, if a parent is accompanying the team, such information may be provided by the school on the school letterhead.

No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.

In case of girl participants, one of the accompanying officials must be female.

The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid identity card issued by the school principal.

Regarding entries:

A junior player can be permitted to play in senior age group, and then the participation in the original group will be forfeited.

Withdrawing School:

If a school, <u>after filling-in its entry</u>, wishes to withdraw from a tournament/meet, it shall give a written request of its intention to do so to the organizing secretary/school.

School withdrawing without informing/requesting the organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty of Rs. 1000/-.

Eligibility:

Only bona fide students shall be eligible to participate in the Inter School tournament/meets. Feeding any non-bona fide student shall lead to disqualification of the team.

A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate.

Incomplete information in any respect is liable for disqualification of team.

Medical Check up may also be applied by the Jury of Appeal appointed by the Organizing School in the cases of average suspicion/protest.

The athlete/player should be within particular age group on 31 December of the year of competition.

A player shall be under 11;14;17 & 19 years of age as on 31st December of the year of the event. Accordingly, for session 2022-23 sports events, the age criteria will be as follows:

- a. Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2009
- b. Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2006
- c. Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2004

All supporting papers verifying the age of the player, etc. in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines and Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/Coach while reporting for participation. The participants must be physically present for reporting one day prior to the event.

The player's right to participate forfeits in case of failure to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original.

Any team/athlete not fulfilling the eligibility criteria before the commencement of the tournament/meet shall not be permitted to participate.

Important:

It shall be mandatory for all the participating schools to provide the following on arrival at venue:

a. The documents for verification in original if asked for.

- b. The team photo with school Principal with the entry proforma, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
- c. To provide CBSE Registration number for student/player studying in class 9th or above.
- d. To supply the eligibility proforma filled in online, countersigned by the concerned Principal.

The organizing school in no case will show the eligibility proforma or any other paper of a team to anyone who lodges the protest. It is only the jury of appeal's prerogative to verify all the documents.

Disqualification:

A player/team may be disqualified/scratched for the following reasons,

- a. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
- b. Inclusion of non-bona fide students in the team.
- c. Misbehavior on ground by athlete or accompanying official.
- d. Use of abusive language by athlete or accompanying official.
- e. Misbehavior with officials/opponents by athlete or accompanying officials.
- f. Indiscipline at the place of stay by athlete or accompanying official.
- g. Damaging the school property.
- h. <u>Indiscipline during the Opening and Closing ceremonies by athlete or accompanying official.</u>
- i. Non-participation in March Past.
